We are pleased to inform you that the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission (PHMC) has approved the historical marker nomination for the **Edward Piszek - founder of Mrs.** Paul's Kitchens **frozen fish production**, **philantropher** marker that you submitted for the 2022 nomination period.

PHMC staff looks forward to working with you to approve the final text and coordinate production and dedication of this marker within the coming year. Alli Davis, Historical Marker Coordinator, is hosting a marker dedication training session on January 9, 2023 at 1:00pm. You are highly encouraged to attend. As announced earlier this year, PHMC is assuming the costs for the fabrication and shipping of Historical Markers. However, the sponsor is still responsible for the coordination and costs associated with the installation and dedication event

Before we can begin the process, you must complete the **Responsibility Agreement**. By completing this form, you indicate that PHMC retains final approval of a historical marker's title and text and that you are responsible for the coordination and costs associated with the installation of the marker and the dedication event. Installation of a marker may require municipal approval so please contact your municipality for more information. The City of Philadelphia requires coordination with the Department of Streets to for all marker installations. Instructions and contact information are enclosed.

A **Permission to Install** form is enclosed. PHMC does require the approval of the property for all marker installations. The form must be signed by the property owner or person with jurisdiction over the location where the marker is to be installed.

The **Shipping Information** form must be completed prior to placing the order for the marker to ensure delivery to the correct location.

When the dedication date is set, please return the enclosed **Dedication Ceremony** form so there is ample time to coordinate the event and approve the invitation and program. It is anticipated that **June 2023** is the earliest date to schedule a dedication due to required time for the text approval process, marker fabrication and delivery, and dedication planning. If no action is taken by you or a sponsoring organization by **June 30, 2025**, the nomination will become inactive and must be resubmitted for the annual evaluation process.

Finally, the enclosed dedication planning material provides you with guidance and information about the planning a marker dedication event and the responsibilities of a nominator and/or local sponsor.
